MGD was initiated with a view to evolve information and making linkage between the villagers and the government. We believed that knowledge would lead to awareness, which would further lead to self-development, empowerment and action..

## **Women Self help Group:-**

The foundation of women empowerment is self-help groups. Maharashtra Gram Darpan has been organizing health camps, nutrition competitions, legal guidance camps, and sports competitions since

2010-11 for the formation of women's self-help groups, training, and overall development of women.

Since **2012**, loans have been provided to eligible groups by NABARD Finance Company (NABFIN). Using this loan, individual and collective livelihood activities are being started by the groups.

Using loans, women have started flour mills and animal husbandry. **Specially, a group in the city has started a kindergarten by taking loans. Today, it is not just a kindergarten but has progressed to a secondary school. Today, 140 girls & Boys are getting quality education in these schools.**

Regular training is conducted on the group's Rules & Regulation, financial transactions, and responsibilities of office bearers.

The group's work is not limited to savings and credit provision, but also includes health camps, national festivals, Tree plantation campen against malnutrition, personal and village cleanliness.

For teenage girls, the aganwadi worker's colleague provides guidance on physical hygiene, diet, organizes competitions for women for nutritional food, kitchen gardening, sports competitions.

## **Tree Plantation**

The organization got the opportunity to work for 3 years for tree plantation and tree enhancement in the 40 km area between the Amravati to Nagpur highway. The organization implemented the work on behalf of women and provided employment opportunities to women.

## **Skill Training**

The institute has been approved by Maharashtra Board of Vocational Education to provide Shivan Kam and Beauty Parlor training Batches of this training have been conducted by the institute.

The institute benefited from this recognition as a training institute in the Watershed Area Program by the Department of Agriculture.

## **AIDS Awareness Program**

An AIDS awareness program was implemented for 120 ASHA workers working under 42 Gram Panchayats in Tivasa Taluka by a joint initiative of Maharashtra Gram Darpan Sanstha and Taluka Health Officer.

For this program, the help of medical officers/staff working in 4 primary health centers in the taluka was taken. The program was conducted at the PSC level.

In this training, technical guidance was given about the disease and information booklets were distributed.


## Jal-Jivan Mission:-



Through this initiative, training, demonstrations, reading materials are being done to make sewage and solid waste management programs accessible to

every person in every village. Maharashtra Gram Darpan Sanstha has completed the training plan for 4205 people from 1587 villages in 14 talukas of Amravati district, 2735 people from 867 villages in 8 talukas of Gondia district, and 2786 people from 700 villages in 5 talukas of Hingoli district.

Under this scheme, it was selected as the implementing agency to prepare a budget for sewage and solid waste management in 43 villages in Dharani taluka, which is predominantly inhabited by tribal in Amravati district.
